3 new buildings to let at Greenham Business Park



3 new buildings are being constructed on vacant land at the top of Albury Way, the park's west entrance. Building work should be completed in 2016.

Each unit will be a steel framed structure with attractive profile steel cladding. Further information and specification available upon request.

Building 37 will be a two storey fully fitted office building with 6,000 sq. ft of office space.
