

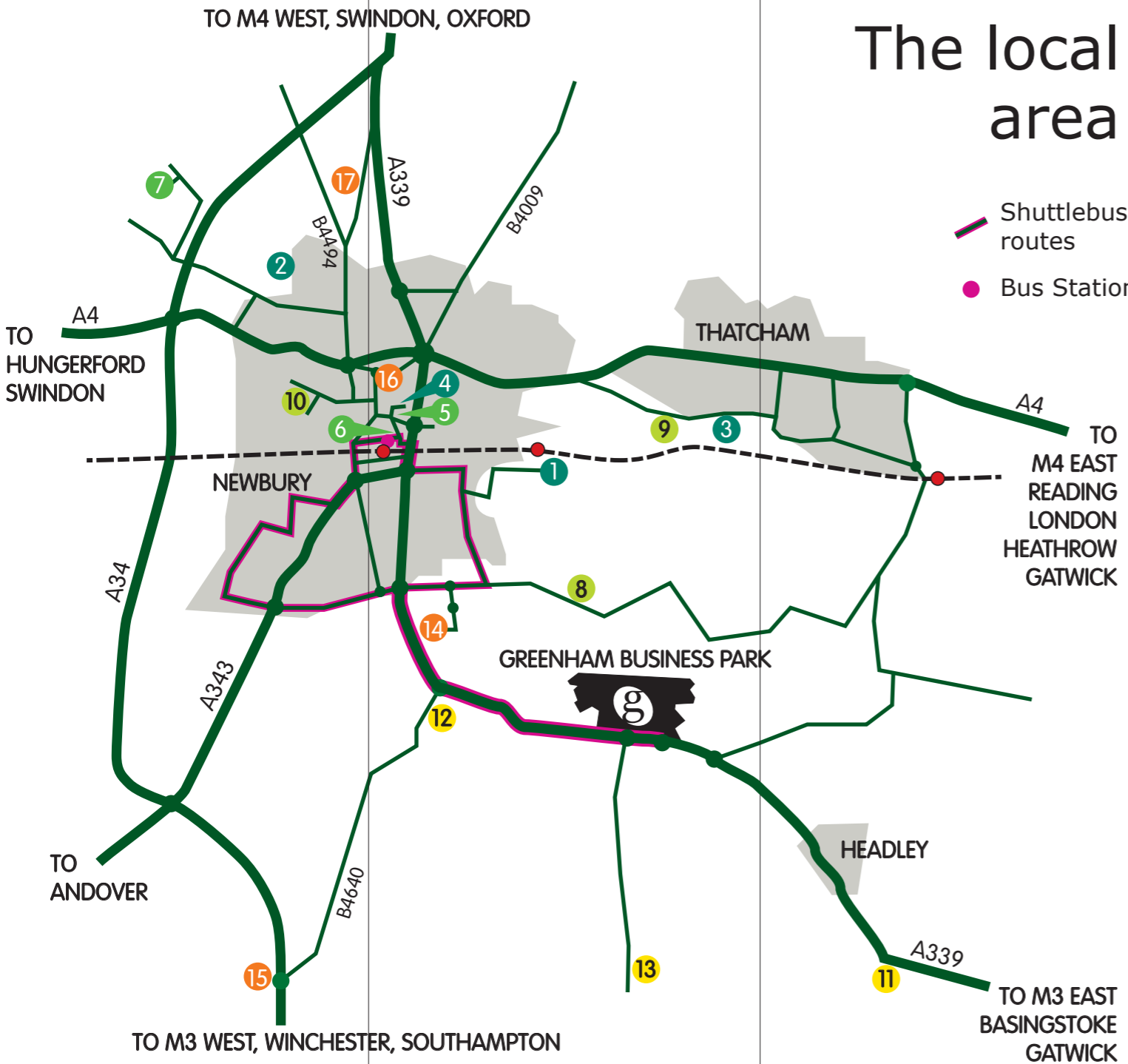

## The War Memorial



A tri-part memorial for the US servicemen who died in two separate flying accidents at Greenham Common in 1944, and to all US servicemen who gave their lives for freedom.

A service is held at the Control Tower every year on 12th December by the Newbury Branch of the Royal British Legion.

Dedicated to, and planted by, the Greenham Peace Women, whose protests against nuclear weapons caught the world's attention during the 1980s, the Peace Garden is on the site of one of the former peace camps.
