Road Resurfacing Project Main Street

We have appointed John Stacey and Sons to complete the next phase of road resurfacing on the business park. The road from the Lindenmuth Way/Third Steet East mini roundabout to the junction with Communications Road will be resurfaced.

The project is scheduled to start on the 1st August, with an anticipated programme time of 6 weeks. For the duration of the project, Main Street will be closed to through traffic and diversionary signage will be in place. The project will be completed in a phased approach, minimising disruption and access to business premises and parking areas.



CCTV Phase 2

The initial phase of CCTV on the business park has proven to be successful. We experimented with new technology to improve coverage in areas of the estate which are hard to reach with underground cables.

The technology has proven to be reliable; we will therefore continue with our plan to improve CCTV coverage on the estate with the installation of additional cameras. CCTV is operated on the estate for the purpose of prevention and detection of crime, safety, and good management.



Baytree Transport

Baytree Transport, a longstanding tenant on the business park since 2008, will soon move into a new 45,000 sq ft purpose-built yard. The yard is situated on the western side of the business park, next to the DVSA test site. Baytree will relocate from their existing yard space over the coming weeks, releasing additional space for refurbishment.
